**Sub: - Selection for formation of a panel of ASTE/AXSTE (Group'B') against  
70% vacancies of S&T department (7 th cycle)**

1. In continuation to this office letter quoted under reference 1, willingness/un-willingness from eligible Group "C" (Technical) Senior Supervisors of S&T department having lien in S E C Railway was called for selection, for formation of a panel for the Group "B" post of ASTE/AXSTE against 70% vacancies for 08 posts (i.e.UR-05, SC-02 & ST-01). Accordingly, a letter regarding fixed-up written examination on 29. 05.2016 alongwith eligibility list was circulated vide ref-2 above. The same was postponed vide ref-03 above for further orders. The competent authority has decided to conduct the written examination for the said selection on **29.02.2020 (SATURDAY) at 10.00 hrs. at S E C Railway Mixed Higher Secondary (English Medium), Bilaspur.** Details of the seating arrangement will be available at the venue.

2. A provisional list of eligible and willing candidates (at Roll No. 01 to 37) is enclosed as Annexure-"A". (Number of candidates being called for the zone of consideration for 08 vacancies (3 X formula) will be 24 in order of seniority and this will be further extended by the number of candidates to the extent of such candidates in the normal zone of consideration who have failed twice (i.e.13 candidates twice failed) in earlier selections, thus total 24+13= 37 candidates were considered). It may be noted that for those in scale PB-2 GP Rs. 4200/- and above, the seniority in grade pay Rs. 4600/- (DOA) has been counted, in terms of extant rules, based on willingness received. In case any candidate is found ineligible for the above selection at any stage, their candidature will be rejected. Those who were willing to appear in the said examination have been retired/transferred/resigned, their names have been deleted accordingly and new names (given willingness in previous instance) are included as per published integrated seniority. Candidates may be directed to report to the Presiding officer on the scheduled date at the venue half an hour before to start of the examination with their identification memo. The format of identification memo is enclosed as Annexure "B". It may be noted that individual identification memo should be given to each candidate.

3. In case any candidate is on leave or on deputation to other Railways/Units or on sick list, the controlling officer concerned should send necessary advice to the authority under whom he is working or the medical authority as the case may be acknowledgement obtained. This may be ensured to avoid any representation later on this issue.

4. The Sr.DPOs/DPOs/SPO/APO should ensure that the ACRs/APARs of the candidates who have volunteered for the above examination, for last 05 years complete in all respects and updated Service Records are available with him to be sent to PCPO (Gaz) at short notice when called for.

5. This is the seventh round of Gazetted selection for S & T department being notified for S E C Railway. It is made clear that employees concerned should clearly satisfy themselves regarding their eligibility, in terms of grade, length of non-fortuitous service and holding lien in S E C Railway. Provisional consideration for selection, based on available records, will not preclude summarily debarring/disqualification of ineligible candidates at any stage.

6. The syllabus for selection to the post Group "B" post of ASTE/AXSTE against 70% quota of Professional subject, Establishment and Finance Rules for written test is enclosed in Annexure "C" which may be circulated widely to all concerned. This syllabus is indicative & not necessarily exhaustive.

7. If any prospective candidate has any issue/suggestion, the same can be submitted to the Gazetted /Conf. Section by which will be examined with reference to extant rules. **It may please be noted that the said selection is being conducted on old patterns.** Any representation after the closure of notification will be not acted upon. The said Selection is provisional and is subject to the final outcome of ongoing litigations/court/CAT cases on the subject.



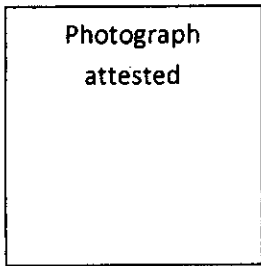
