"ACTIVITIES COVERED OVER SECR DURING II YEAR OF THE MISSION"

Swachh Bharat Mission started over SECR with administering the SBM pledge on 02.10.2014. 2nd year Mission activities started from 02.10.2015 during which SECR took number of steps and some of major initiatives taken by SECR are as follows:

A) General:

- SBM pledge was administered on 02.10.2015 in the HQ office by GM/SECR and also DRMs in their respective divisional HQrs. Various Unit Incharges have also administered SBM pledge in their field units.
- Cleanliness campaign was organized on all the major stations & field units where Hon'ble MPs/MLAs and also senior Railway officers participated. At Bilaspur station, GM/SECR, DRM/BSP and other dignitaries joined the drive.
- In order to improve public awareness, number of programmes like Nukkad Nataks, rallies etc were also organized.

B) Theme based cleanliness drives:

The following drives were completed over SECR.

- Upbhokta Pakwada observed from 26.5.15 to 09.06.15.
- Sardar Patel United Clean India Drive launched from 11.10.15 to 31.10.15 for railway stations & trains.
- Railway Colonies drive from 16.12.15 to 31.12.15.
- Railway Hospitals & Health Units drive from 15.02.16 to 28.02.16.
- Offices, Service Buildings and other work places including Workshops from 28.02.16 to 15.02.16.
- To increase significantly the range, intensity and visibility of various activities relating to 'Swachhata' at present the following theme based cleanliness drive have successfully been completed recently.

- i) All work places like factories / workshops, sheds, depots etc. from 01.05.16 to 15.05.16.
- ii) All Govt. offices from 16.05.16 to 31.06.16.
- iii) All Railway colonies from 01.07.16 to 15.07.16.

C) Special Initiative of SECR for improving cleanliness & hygiene in passenger services and Increasing public awareness :

- House keeping contracts implemented at 112 stations.
- 198 stations covered in various drives for cleanliness.
- Mechanised cleaning contracts at 17 stations are functional.
- 500 public toilets over SECR inspected and attended for deficiencies.
- Monitoring cleanliness through CC TVs started at 16 stations over SECR.
- Video on SBM is also shown on platforms.
- 8279 anti-littering cases were apprehended and an amount of Rs.518328/- was realized.
- Exhibition displaying various innovative models to improve garbage isposal/maintenance of hygienic state in colonies increasing public aware organized in railway school, Bilaspur .
- 'May I Help' Booths arranged to receive complaints on cleanliness.
- OBHS introduced in 19 out of 20 trains over SECR.
- 922 bio toilets have been fitted in total 249 coaches of SECR running in various passenger trains.

D) Improvement in Hospitals and Railway Colonies :

- Model colony concept started and developed at Manendragarh. Model colony concept is also planned for Bilaspur.
- Numerous drains in various colonies over SECR got thoroughly cleaned & repaired.
- Vegetation growth in colonies removed.
- Tree plantation programme in various road side stations, colonies organised.

E) Other initiatives taken by SECR improving hygienic health:

- Water Recycling Plants installed at Bilaspur and Durg coaching complexes to save water.
- Rain Water Harvesting work completed at 16 locations and work is in progress at 55 other locations.
- Around 3500 trees planted over SECR during Rail Hamsafar week itself and work to plant over 15 lac trees saplings in current year by SECR is in progress.
- Painting competition, Quiz competition, Drawing competitions were held in Divl.HQs to bring awareness among passengers, public and railwaymen's families on cleanliness.
- One page has been dedicated for SBM on SECR Website. Any person may view information on SBM in HQ/Divisions over SECR.
- 48 Railwaymen awarded for their contribution in SBM. Shri Abodh Kumar, JE has been awarded at Board level during Environment Day 2016 for his personal contribution towards rain water harvesting.
- "Rail Hamsafar week" was organized from 26.05.16 to 01.06.16 in which Sr. officers inspected every nook and corner of the station premises/units and got the areas cleaned. In addition passenger amenities /facilities for passengers were checked and deficiencies attended.
- During various cleanliness drives areas like parks, institutions, staircases, terraces, roofs was intensively covered.
