Sub: Roll on-Roll off (RORO) operations and classification.



Ministry of Railways have decided to notify the freight rates for Roll on-Roll off (RORO) services to be operated over Indian Railways (including DFCCIL).

2.0 Accordingly, Roll on-Roll off (RORO) services shall be operated as under:

- i. The RORO services is hereby notified as a Commodity in the Goods Tariff No.49 Pt.1, Vol.II as under:

- ii. The Freight Rate Table indicating the base freight per wagon for loaded vehicles and empty vehicles/ empty flats is attached as Annexure-I.
- iii. All commodities under Main commodity head "Coal & Coke"; Iron ore (all types); & Military traffic shall be the excluded commodities under the RORO services.
- iv. The rake shall be charged for the corresponding numbers of loaded vehicles and empty vehicles/ empty flats. Illustration attached as Annexure-II.
- v. The Ro-Ro service shall be subject to levy of all ancillary charges/sub-charges/cess etc. as notified from time to time.
- vi. The Ro-Ro services shall be subject to levy of Over Dimensional Consignment (ODC) charges, Power block as and where applicable.
- vii. The customer shall furnish full details of truck/semi-articulated trailer/truck trailer/rigid body vehicle w.r.t. its dimensions, tare weight, commodity weight in the vehicle, gross weight of the vehicle, names of the commodities in detail viz. their weight/quantity/nature(liquid, solid, packed, loose etc) loaded in the truck. Dimension of Vehicle shall be within the Loading Diagram/dimensions as and



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- when issued by RDSO for respective routes. The customer shall be responsible and liable under rules for the correctness of the declaration.
- viii. The weight of the truck/semi-articulated trailer/truck trailer/rigid body vehicle as declared by the customer and taken from the weighbridge (Dharma Kanta) which, is duly certified by the metrology department of the State concerned will be accepted.
 - ix. For charging purpose, the dimensions of the truck/semi-articulated trailer/ truck trailer/rigid body as declared by the customer and taken from details given by the manufacturer of the vehicle shall be accepted.
 - x. The Ro-Ro services shall be allowed as "to & fro service". Zonal Railway shall decide minimum number of trips per month for each rake duly considering the opportunity cost of the BRN wagon. The number of trips should be reviewed periodically depending on the wagon demand and opportunity cost.
 - xi. *Force-majeure*: Extraordinary event or circumstances beyond the control of the parties, such as a war, strike, riot, crime, or an event described by the legal term act of God (hurricane, earthquake, volcanic eruption etc.) prevents one or both the parties from fulfilling their obligations, the prescribed number of rake shall be adjusted in proportion to the time lost.
 - xii. In case the customer fails to load stipulated number of trips in a month, then a penalty of 5% on the notional freight for shortfall in that particular month shall be recovered from the customer. Illustration attached as Annexure-III.
 - xiii. Modification of rake, as authorized by RDSO, shall be mutually decided between Railway and customer and the customer shall bear the cost of modification. The modification of the rake shall be subject to the approval of Traffic Transportation Directorate of Ministry of Railways. In case the customer does not offer traffic after modification of the rake, he/she shall be liable to bear the cost of reinstatement of the rake. Some security provision will be kept in this regard as agreed between Railway and the customer.
 - xiv. After modification of rake into Ro-Ro rake the standard rake size and minimum number of wagons to be loaded for Ro-Ro rake shall be the same as was before modification of rake.
 - xv. Allocation of rakes will be done by Zonal Railways in consultation with Traffic Transportation Directorate of Railway Board.
 - xvi. Free time of three hours each shall be allowed at loading and unloading point. Demurrage and wharfage shall be levied as per extant guidelines.
 - xvii. To ensure safety during transportation, customer shall be responsible for-
 - a. Proper securing of cargo/commodity inside/on the truck/semi-articulate trailer/ truck trailer/ rigid body vehicle.



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- b. Proper securing of truck/semi-articulated trailer/truck trailer/rigid body vehicle by locks/lashing on the wagon including compliance of guidelines as and when issued by RDSO in this regard.
- c. Securing as mentioned in para (1) & (2) above can be checked by the authorized representative of Railways.
- d. Customer shall bear the liability for any lapse noticed, at any stage, in securing as mentioned in para (1) & (2) above.
- xviii. Person(s) accompanying trucks shall have to purchase 2nd class tickets for the journey of equivalent value as per coaching tariff. A maximum of 2 persons per truck including driver will be permitted.
- xix. The Ro-Ro service should be introduced only on sections where the line capacity utilization for end to end movement is up to 70% (apart from DFCCIL network). For sections where line capacity is more than 70%, operational feasibility of introducing RORO service may be examined on case-to-case basis.
- xx. CRIS shall make necessary provisions in the system for charging this movement in the TMS.
- xxi. FOIS/CRIS will submit a report half yearly basis indicating the number of Ro-Ro vehicles loaded and earning thereon

3.0 This shall come into force w.e.f. 15.07.2022 and shall remain valid till further advice.

4.0 This issues in consultation with Freight Marketing Directorate, Mechanical Directorate and with the concurrence of Finance Directorate of Ministry of Railways.




