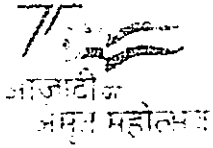

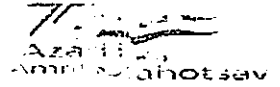

**Sub.: Issue of Permission for advance stacking and Penalty clause for frequent failure of EIMWB at SPVs.**

**Ref: WR letter No.C/G/392/6/BDRCL Vol-II dated 25.07.2022**

In reference to the subject matter, the clarification sought by Western Railway has been examined and it is clarified as under:

- 1) Goods shed/Terminals owned by the SPV lines on their system should be treated at par with PFTs as per FM Policy for the purpose of stacking permission. Since no stacking permission is required for PFTs, the same rule will apply for Terminals on the SPVs.
- 2) Penalty clause for failure of EIMWB are prescribed in the recommendations of the 'Committee on Weighbridge & Weighment', 2018 (para 3.4) and the same have been incorporated in the GCT policy, 2021 issued by Railway Board. It is decided that these may also be made applicable on same lines at SPVs/Goods shed owned by SPVs.

This issues in consultation of Commercial (Freight Marketing & Rates) Directorate and Traffic Transportation Directorate of Railway Board.
