Sub:- Transfer of RPF/RPSF personnel.

In continuation of Standing Order No.2/96 dated 27.5.96 the following modifications regarding tenure of postings of enrolled members of the Force and Officers of RPF/PSF are hereby ordered:-

1. The tenure of posting for various ranks will be as under:-

- |  |   |                      |
|--|---|----------------------|
| i) Superior Officers                         | : | 4 years at one post. |
| ii) Inspectors independent in charge of post | : | 4 years at one post. |
| iii) Other enrolled members of the Force     | : | 5 Years at one post. |


iv) Enrolled members posted in SIB, Fire Branch, prosecution branch, Drivers, Ancillary & Security Aides Staff can be allowed one more tenure by the concerned CSC on merits. Similarly CSC will be empowered to grant approval of stay for one more year beyond the normal tenure of posting to enrolled members of the Force as mentioned at (ii) and (iii) above.

2. Stations like Delhi, Calcutta, Madras, Bombay etc. where there are number of posts and concentration of staff, members of the Force may be allowed to continue at such stations maximum upto two tenures by CSC concerned.

3. Transfers of constables and Naiks as far as possible may be done within the division.

4. Eligibility for Inter Rly transfer and RPSF to RPF and vice versa will be 5 years.
