DIRECTIVE NO: 8

In exercise of powers conferred under Rule 23 of RPF Rules, 1987 read with Section 8 (2) of the RPF Act, 1957 (as amended by Act 60 of 1985), the undersigned hereby issues the following Directive:

As a result of implementation of recommendations of 4th Pay Commission, the posts in the rank of Constables, Naiks and Head Constables which were Group 'D' posts, have been classified as Group 'C'. As per extant Railway Board's instructions candidates have option to use Hindi or English for written tests at the time of recruitment. In view of this, it is directed that in future at the time of recruitment of Constables and Sub-Inspectors in RPF/RPSF, candidates will have option to use either Hindi or English only for their written tests. This will apply to all future promotional tests also.

This Directive shall come into force with immediate effect.
