## DIRECTIVE NO. 9

In exercise of powers conferred under Rule 28 of Railway Protection Force Rules, 1987 read with section 8 (2) of the Railway Protection Force Act, 1957 (as amended by Act 60 of 1985) the undersigned hereby issues the following directive:

This directive is issued in supersession of Directive No. 7 issued vide letter of even number dated 26.8.92.

Sub: Recruitment of Inspector (Prosecution) Grade-II and Sub-Inspector (Prosecution) in RPF.

  Grade-II and Sub-Inspector (Pros.). 50% marks will be allotted for written test, 30% marks for academic record and outstanding performance in legal profession and 20% marks for viva-voce. The written examination will be on law and procedure. The minimum qualifying marks would be 60% for general candidates and 50% for SC/ST candidates in all subjects separately.
