Directive No.22

The Directive No. 21 issued in exercise of powers conferred under Rule 28 of the RPF Rules 1987, is hereby modified, under the same Rules, to the extent indicated below:

The following explanatory note may be added to the Directive at the end of the table (schedule) below the clause "Appointments and Promotions":

"For the purpose of promotion under Rule 70, in the case of technical categories, the tests shall consist of the following:

- (a) Practical test (to assess the technical knowledge and personality of the candidate) 25 marks
- (b) Evaluation of service records 25 marks.

 The same procedure shall be adopted for promotions under Rule 72 also.

In case a candidate is short of having the minimum number of five (5) ACRs for evaluation for want of sufficient years of service in the feeder grade since his appointment to the grade, the marks awarded to him for the available ACRs should be notionally increased for the five years in proportion to the marks awarded to him for the available ACRs. The method is illustrated below:

Illustration: When a Constable with 2 years' regular service is being considered for promotion to the grade of Driver Grade III:

- (1) Total Number of ACRs available 2
- (2) Marks awarded for the 2 ACRS, (say) 7
- (3) Proportionate marks for 5 ACRs $7/2X5 = 17 \frac{1}{2}$ marks.

In the event a candidate has not secured 5 ACRs in the feeder grade for want of sufficient service in the feeder grade, ACRs secured by him in the immediate lower grade preceding his promotion to the feeder grade shall be considered.

Illustration:

Eligibility for promotion of Driver Gr.I to MCM Grade - 3 years' regular service in the grade of Driver Gr.I

In the above case, a candidate with only 3 years' service as Driver Gr.I shall have only 3 ACRs in his favour. If it is assumed that the selection is being held in July, 2005, the candidate who is eligible for promotion is appointed as Driver Grade one in Jan. 2002, he will have ACRs for the years 2002, 2003 and 2004. To evaluate 5 ACRs, the ACRs of the candidate for the years 2000 and 2001 (as Driver Gr.II) shall be counted.

An amendment to Rule 71.1 and 71.2 of RPF Rules 1987 is being made to incorporate the above changes in the RPF Rules.

Till necessary amendment to the Rules is made, the above modification to Directive No.21 shall be in force.
