In exercise of the powers conferred under Rule 8 of the RPF Rules 1987 read with section 8 of RPF Act 1957, the undersigned hereby issues the following Directive:

**DIRECTIVE No. 23**

Sub:- Ex cadre post in RPSF for induction and promotion.

1. Considering the need for efficient and smooth handling/operating of the wireless equipments in RPSF, it is decided to set up wireless units in RPSF. The Ex. Cadre posts in Wireless Unit shall be in following ranks:

1	Head Constable/Wireless
2	ASI/Wireless
3	Sub Inspector/Wireless
4	Inspector/Wireless

2. The ex-cadre posts in Wireless Units shall be manned by personnel with adequate training/skills drawn from executive Branch of RPSF
3. The total strength of this ex-cadre shall be decided by the Chief Security Commissioner from time to time on the basis of the need and workload. However, the strength of this ex cadre and the permanent cadre of Executive shall not at any time exceed the sanctioned strength of the Executive.
4. The staff (Constable to Sub Inspector) shall be given next higher grade or be inducted against the ex-cadre posts in Wireless Unit irrespective of the years of service in the parent cadre.

5. Induction of the RPSF staff against the ex. Cadre posts shall be by transfer on deputation basis as under:

S.No.	Post	Eligibility
1.	Head Constable	Constables with two years regular service and must have qualified the Wireless Operator Gr.III course.
2.	ASI	Head Constables with two years regular service and must have qualified the Wireless Operator Gr.II course.
3.	Sub Inspector	ASI with two years regular service and must have qualified the Wireless Operator Gr.I course.
4.	Inspector	SI with two years regular service and must have qualified the Wireless Operator Gr.I course.

6. The staff so inducted in Wireless unit will have the option to avail pay of deputation post or cadre pay plus deputation allowance.
7. The staff inducted in the ex. Cadre /wireless unit shall be on deputation basis initially for a period of three years which is extendable up to five years with the approval of competent authorities. Beyond fourth year, the deputation allowance will not be admissible and for extending the deputation period, consent of the deputationists will be necessary. Their lien shall remain in their parent cadre i.e. Executive branch of RPSF.
