Directive No. 24

In exercise of the powers conferred under Rule 28 of the RPF Rules, 1987 read with Section 8(2) (as amended by Act 60 of 1985), the undersigned hereby issues the following directives in regard to appointment and promotions in Artisan and Ancillary Cadre:

1. There shall be four grades in the cadre of Artisan Staff and Ancillary staff as mentioned below;-
